We have 4 distinct walls;

*The Accumulated Giving,*

*In Memory,*

*Baby Bouquet and*

*The CT Scanner.*

Each wall is unique in its set of donors and meaning and has a special place in our hospital. The "Accumulated Giving" wall, in the main lobby, tracks each gift a donor gives; once over \$1500 the donor's name is added. The "In Memory" wall, in the hallway linking to Peace Villa, honours the lives of lost loved ones, with names added after donations total over \$1000. The "Baby Bouquet" wall is all about babies! Naturally, it hangs in our Birthing Centre. With a \$125 gift, the name and date of your bundle of joy is added. The "CT Scanner" wall is in the waiting room in the diagnostic imaging department. It recognizes those who supported the "Slice for Life" campaign which saw the CT Scanner installed at our hospital. All donor names from the old hospital have been transferred to the new recognition displays. Each wall proudly hangs on hospital walls recognizing those who have donated and share the Foundation's commitment to enhancing patient care and comfort at our Hospital and Peace Villa facility.

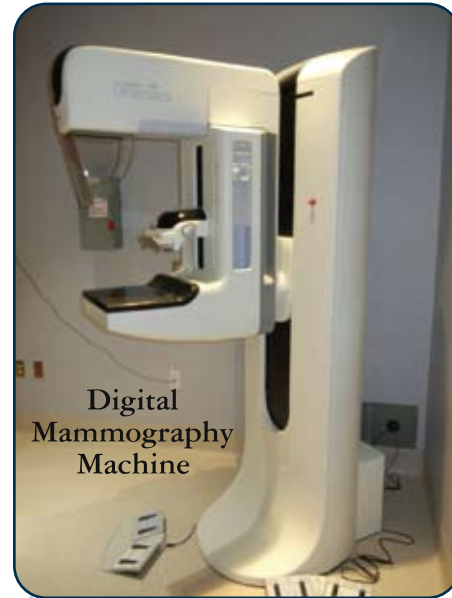

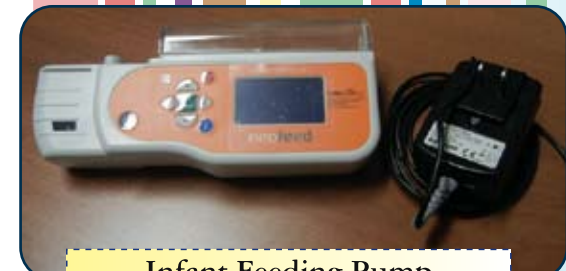

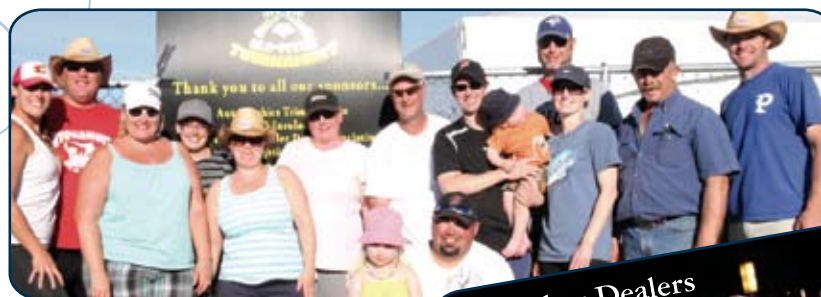
